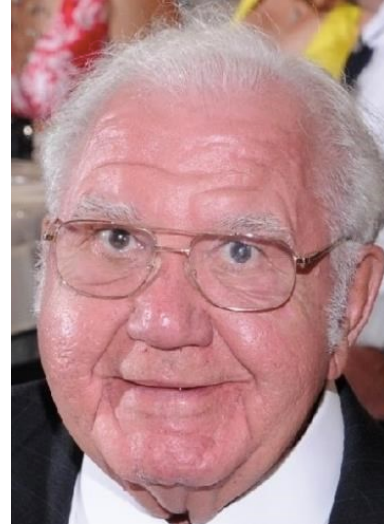


Remembering Joe J. Pivarnik
