

Three-Day Fastener Training in Illinois POSTPONED, Rescheduled for October

“Fundamentals of Threaded Fasteners and Joint Design for Engineers and Designers,” the inaugural session of a new fastener training opportunity, originally scheduled for April 28-30, 2020, has been POSTPONED due to the COVID-19 public health emergency.
